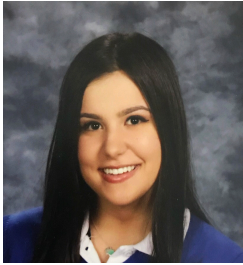


Amanda Rego
