Anais SOLARTE is a Franco-Colombian born in Paris. She’s currently studying in Grenoble, where she’s going through a double career in law and foreign applied languages, with a specialisation in



administration and international policies. Very interested in criminal international law, she wishes to work in the future as an international lawyer or as a criminologist.

During her life, she has met lots of Colombians victims of the conflict that have left their home-country to save their lives. Her own mother and family, from Putumayo, a region directly affected by the conflict, left Colombia in the early 1990’s to seek the asylum in France.

The history of her family pushes her to struggle against the violations of human rights by helping people victims of persecutions. She has worked as a volunteer in the head office of CHRIO in Toronto, Canada, where she met people from all over the world who have been victims of violations of human rights in their countries and she decided to carry on the same work in France.

As she grew up in Paris, she has witnessed social fractures and knows the difficulty for arriving foreigners to integrate into the society. Her role in France is too assist the refugee seekers by helping them throughout the process of refugee claim, to help them to understand the French system, but also to provide counselling for people endangered around the world. Also Anais is a volunteer at Collective Human Rights Defenders “Laura Acosta International Organization COHURIDELA.

As CHRIO’s Goodwill Ambassador, she is also responsible for generating public awareness and understanding of human rights issues related to Human Rights in France.
