Venezuelan Lawyer, 42 years of age, graduated from the Central University of Venezuela (UCV) with a Specialization in Criminal Law; Masters in Personnel Administration and Management - Specialization in Police Functions; Advanced Teaching Course in Higher Education; Diploma Course in Criminal Justice and Contemporary Subjects related to Delinquency; amongst others. Worked as a Prosecutor in the 10<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> Circuits of the Public Ministry, both at a National level.

In my area of Human Rights, I have conducted several Workshops and Courses, such as "Human Rights in the Protection System of the United Nations" and "How to be a defender of HR"; Co-Author of the National Law of Amnesty and Reconciliation. Member of the Inter-American Federation of Lawyers. I Speak English and French.

Currently, I am an external Consultant in Criminal matters for the Metropolitan Mayor's Office of Caracas; Human Rights Coordinator of the NGO "Popular Center for the Formation of Citizens"; I also practice Criminal Law privately and am currently in-charge of the defense of several students, on an ad-hoc basis, who were deprived of their Human Rights when they were arbitrarily detained by the Venezuelan government.
